You will need to make arrangements for your artwork to be shipped to Holden, or for you to accompany it. Please see the website to understand our remote location and transportation arrangements. Holden Village will cover costs for up to two nights' lodging – everything else (boat and lodging, parking and travel, shipping to and from the Village, artwork insurance) will be your responsibility.

After completing your proposal, please email it to arts@holdenvillage.org and attach relevant images, with the proposed exhibition title in the subject line. Limit the size of the email to 2MB, or include a link to photos of your work. Our network is limited, and a larger file may not come through for a long time. You may send multiple emails, but please label them in the subject line accordingly.
