

Holden Village Registration Information and Registration Form

Reservations Required

- Please return the reservation form below, including a deposit totalling the first night's lodging for each person.
- Reserve only as much time as you actually plan to stay, as you will be charged for the full number of nights you have reserved even if you decide to leave early or come late.
- Reservations for June through September will be accepted only if postmarked on or after January 1st. Reservations for the Thanksgiving and Christmas/New Years holidays will be accepted only if postmarked on or after October 1st. Reservations for other times of the year can be made at any time. Reservations can also be made online at www.holdenvillage.org
- Group reservation forms are available from the Registrar for groups of 15 - 55 people, for at least a 4-night stay.
- Individuals added to your party after you make reservations must be treated as a new reservation and must follow our reservation procedure listed above.
- It is inadvisable to come without a reservation.

Cancellations

- Deposits are refundable only if cancellation notice is postmarked at least 30 days prior to date of arrival.
- If you cancel with less than a 30-day notice you will forfeit your deposit -- the deposit cannot be applied as payment for another member of your party, and you cannot roll over your deposit for a future visit.

Payment (Sorry, No Credit Cards except Online)

- Deposits will be applied to the cost of your visit to Holden. Payment may be made in cash, personal or travelers checks. Canadian checks should be labeled "US\$."
- If you cancel fewer than 30 days before your arrival date, your refund will include all payments less the deposit.

- Savings Opportunity: A 5% discount is available for anyone who pays in full by March 1 (this applies to June through September reservations only).

Housing

- Guest rooms are in simple and comfortable lodges. Rooms accommodate 2 to 4+ persons and assignments vary according to size and makeup of the Village at the time. Families are typically housed in one bunk/family room. There are no private bathrooms available.
- Singles usually share with one other person during the summer months.
- Special requests are met whenever possible. Changes requested upon arrival are very difficult, if not impossible, to make. Please provide us with any information required to make your stay as comfortable as possible.

Handicapped Options

- Holden Village is a place of rocky walkways and uneven terrain. Those with mobility difficulties may not find it easy to get around. Unfortunately, all winter guestrooms are on second floor and are not wheelchair accessible. (at least November through April).
- Handicapped accessible guest rooms are available in the summer, as well as a limited number of bathrooms with handicapped accessible showers and toilets. Please indicate these needs on the registration form.
- Summer only: The village operates a van with a wheelchair lift. An electric wheelchair is also available. Please indicate these needs on the registration form.

Holden is a not-for-profit adult/family retreat center open to all people regardless of race, color, gender, age, religion, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, or handicap.

Travel to Holden

• Holden Village is located in the Cascade Mountains near Lake Chelan and is accessible only by boat. The boat can be boarded in the town of Chelan or at Field's Point Landing, 16 miles uplake on the south shore. The port for Holden Village is Lucerne. For those traveling by private car, supervised parking is provided at Field's Point Landing for a small fee.

• If you choose to leave Holden via the Lady Express you may 1) buy a round-trip Lady II ticket and upgrade for an additional fare the day you leave Holden, or 2) buy a combo ticket of one-way Lady II and one-way Lady Express.

• The most economical way to visit Stehekin from May 1 to October 31 is to buy a round-trip ticket to Stehekin on Lady II, get off boat at Lucerne for Holden, take boat from Lucerne to Stehekin for a 1 ½ hour visit any day of your Holden stay.

• Holden will meet the boat on all Sundays in the winter through December 31 and beginning again on May 1.

• From October 1 - April 30 there is only one bus run (in the morning) to meet the boat going uplake on the days indicated due to unstable road conditions at this time of year. On your day of departure from Holden you may wait in the A-frame structure at Lucerne for 2 ½ hours (wood stove heat source) and board the boat on its downlake run or you may go to Stehekin and then to Field's Point or Chelan (\$4.50 extra if ticket is purchased at Chelan/Field's Point when you arrive, \$15.00 extra if purchased at Lucerne when you depart).

• Boat fares are established by the boat company and are subject to change. For more information about boat schedule and fares, call the Lake Chelan Boat Company, 509-682-4584.

• Parking at Field's Point costs \$6 per night; \$30 per week; \$65 per month. (Extra fee for vehicles requiring two spaces)
