POSTION SUMMARY

Responsible for the provision and maintenance of the Village fire detection, alarm, sprinkler, suppression systems, and hose houses. Basic knowledge of fire-fighting, plumbing, and electrical systems is helpful.

MAJOR FUNCTIONS (principal duties and responsibilities; such as categories supported, staff size, volume managed, etc.)

Specific responsibilities include but are not limited to the following:

- Makes monthly rounds through all buildings checking fire system status and alerting supervisor of hazards.
- Utilizes power point software to present fire safety and response curricula.
- Works under the training and mentorship of the Fire Brigade Chief.
- Will become a member of the fire brigade.
