



Family Work Option 2023 Application

We are so glad that your family is interested in volunteering at Holden Village! Family Option is a program that was developed to allow families with school-age children (ages 4 to 17) to serve on staff in the summer. Adult volunteers who wish to bring children may only do so if they are the parent or legal guardian of those children.

Family Work Option Logistics

Two-adult families: Both adults participate in Garbology and Dish Team. If any of your children are under 12, one adult volunteers full-time (36 hrs/week) and one adult volunteers half-time (during youth program hours). If all of your children are 12 and over, both adults volunteer full-time (36 hrs/week).

Single-adult families: The adult participates in Garbology and Dish Team. If any of your children are under 12, you volunteer half-time (during youth program hours). If all of your children are 12+, you work full-time (36 hrs/week).

All Families: Youth 12 and over participate in Garbology and Dish Team. Youth ages 14 & 15 volunteer half time in a work area in addition to Garbology and Dish Team. Youth ages 16 & 17 work full-time in a work area in addition to Garbology and Dish Team. Youth 18 and up can apply independently as adults and should submit an application according to the instructions on the [Holden Job Board](#). Work area positions and descriptions are listed on our website on the [Holden Job Board](#). Please only select positions that are open to Short-Term applications. All adults also participate in Garbology and Dish Team. Garbology and Dish Team involve serving the Village by sorting trash and recyclables, composting food waste, washing dishes, and cleaning the dining hall after meals.

Childcare: Children ages 4-15 will participate in Holden's youth programs, which are not available for the whole workday. This means that for children 4-11, one adult works half-time during youth program hours (mornings) and cares for their own children in the afternoon. For children 12 and over, there may be some unsupervised time when there is no youth programming and the adults are at work. Holden is unable to provide childcare outside of our normal guest youth programming. If your child is 12 and over and requires more supervision, please apply as though your child is under 12.

Housing: Families tend to be housed in one room with multiple beds with a shared bathroom down the hall.

When will you hear? If you submit your application by the March 1st Priority Deadline, you will hear from us by April 1st. If you submit your application after the Priority Deadline, you will hear from us by May 1st, 2023. No applications will be accepted after April 30th. If invited, you will be sent notice by email that will indicate your arrival and departure dates and tentative work assignments. If you cannot honor these dates, please notify us immediately so we can see if we can change the dates or fill the position with someone else.

Holden Village has carefully followed national, state, and local guidance for maintaining health and wellness throughout the COVID-19 pandemic. Services Assistant - Helps the Services Team in housekeeping and laundry tasks. Housekeeping tasks include cleaning lodges, guest rooms, and program facilities. Laundry tasks include washing, hanging and folding linens.

Kitchen Assistant - Support Head Cooks in the tasks of daily kitchen operation including but not limited to: food preparation, cooking and baking, Dining Hall upkeep and sanitation tasks.

Lawns and Gardens - works under the supervision of the Lawns & Gardens Head to help maintain the grounds of Holden. Tasks include but are not limited to: mowing lawns, watering lawns and plants, weeding and raking.

Maverick - Performs a variety of tasks throughout the Village that involve manual labor. Tasks include but are not limited to: lifting, carrying, loading and unloading, woodcutting and hauling wood.

Narnia Assistant - Must be 18 plus. Assists with the supervision of children ages 4 to 11 and keeps educational areas clean and sanitary.

Art Studio Assistant - Assists the Art Studio Technicians in welcoming, planning, and teaching a variety of art classes and upkeeping the Art Studio. May also assist the Potter with tasks in the Pottery Studio.

Snack Bar Assistant - Great option for 14 & 15 year olds working part time. Scoops Ice Cream at Holden Villages Snack Bar. Keeps Snack Bar clean and sanitary.
