Growing from the love of Christ, Holden Village is a courageous community that welcomes all people into the wilderness to form and renew their relationships with God, the earth, and each other.


ALL ARE WELCOME

Your journey is exceptional because no roads lead directly to Holden Village!



You'll take a scenic two to four hour boat ride on Lake Chelan followed by a 10 mile ride on a Holden vehicle up to the Village. The boat docks are located near Chelan, WA, which is 1 hour from Wenatchee and 4 hours from Seattle.

Holden Village is open year-round! Visit as an individual, family, or group to experience the seasonal rhythms of an intentional Village community.

SUMMER offers a wide variety of art classes, children's activities, and teaching sessions from visiting faculty.

FALL, WINTER, AND SPRING offer a quiet retreat and ample time for outdoor recreation and rest.
